### **L. "DROP 2" VOICINGS**

This clean-cut triadic sound may seem tame to jazz ears, but don't dismiss it out of hand - it has its uses There are lots of possibilities for using more adventurous slash chords in a jazz context, but arguably the two most useful are: E/C B b/C giving C Δ+5 C7sus (9)
